

First days

- Let people know
- Choose a funeral director

- Find a will
- Choose a final resting place

First weeks

- Register the death
- Check what financial help you can get
- Find grief support

First months

- Work through the affairs of someone who has died
- Tell the bank so their accounts are frozen
- Cancel any benefits or pensions
- Cancel their drivers licence and passport
- File a final tax or estate return
- Find grief support
